### **SECTION 4: First aid measures**

#### 4.1. Description of first aid measures

If any health problems are manifested or if in doubt, inform a doctor and show him information from this safety data sheet. If unconscious, put the person in the stabilized (recovery) position on his side with his head slightly bent backwards and make sure that airways are free; never induce vomiting. If the person vomits by himself, make sure that the vomit is not inhaled. In life threatening conditions first of all provide resuscitation of the affected person and ensure medical assistance. Respiratory arrest - provide artificial respiration immediately. Cardiac arrest - provide indirect cardiac massage immediately.

#### If inhaled

Terminate the exposure immediately; move the affected person to fresh air. Protect the person against growing cold. Provide medical treatment if irritation, dyspnoea or other symptoms persist.

#### If on skin

Remove contaminated clothes. Wash the affected area with plenty of water, lukewarm if possible. Soap, soap solution or shampoo should be used if there is no skin injury. Note: If the product sticks to the skin and cannot be removed using water and cleaning products or edible oil, do not use force and leave for specialized treatment.

### If in eyes

Rinse eyes immediately with a flow of running water, open the eyelids (also using force if needed); remove contact lenses immediately if worn by the affected person. Rinsing should continue at least for 10 minutes. Provide medical treatment, specialized if possible. Note: If the product sticks to the skin and cannot be removed using water and cleaning products or edible oil, do not use force and leave for specialized treatment.

#### If swallowed

DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING - even the inducing of vomiting by itself may cause complications (i.e. inhalation of the substance in airways and lungs, for example, in case of detergents and other substances that produce foam or mechanical damage to the mucous membrane of the pharynx may be caused). If possible, provide a small amount of activated carbon (1-2 crushed tablets). For persons with no symptoms, call the Toxicological Information Centre to decide about the need of medical treatment; provide information about the substances or composition of the product from the original packaging or the Safety Data Sheet of the product. ### 8.2. Exposure controls
